Sub:- Conduct of SSC Advanced Supplementary Examinations, May / June 2010 – Instructions to be issued to all the Heads of Schools including Clerical staff and office Sub-ordinates to be present during Summer Vacation – Requested – Regarding.

I wish to submit that the Government has issued orders in the reference 1st cited in connection with the conduct of SSC Advanced Supplementary Examinations in the last week of May of every year, in order to facilitate the pass candidates to take admissions in the 1st year intermediate course without loss of an academic year.

In this connection, I wish to add that the SSC Public Examinations March, 2010 were completed by 13 – 04 – 2010 and the results are proposed to be released by 4th week of May, 2010. Soon after the publication of the results, the Nominal Roll extracts of the failed candidates will be sent to all the schools in the State. Accordingly the failed candidates have to remit the examination fee to appear for the SSC Advanced Supplementary Examinations to be held in June, 2010. The SSC Advanced Supplementary Examinations will in 4th week of June 2010 tentatively. The results will be released in the last week of July, 2010. tentatively.

The presence of all the Headmasters / Clerical Staff / Office Sub-ordinates are essentially required for the following purposes:-

- (i) To receive extraction of nominal rolls of failed candidates.
- (ii) To receive failed memos of the failed candidates.
- (iii) To receive and remit the examination fee.

In view of the above, I request you to kindly issue instructions to all the District Educational Officers on the following items as were done for the SSC Advanced Supplementary Examinations held in June, 2009.

1. To prevent all the Heads of Secondary Schools under all Managements along with their non-teaching Staff including Office Su-ordinate personnel from availing summer vacation, with effect from **23-04-2010 to 11-06-2010**.
2. To direct the teachers who are drafted for Invigilation work, to report to the D.E.Os one week before the commencement of the examinations to receive the instructions in connection with the work of the SC Advanced Supplementary Examinations, June 2010.
3. Earned Leave may be preserved for all those employees who are prevented From availing summer vacation as per leave rules.
